

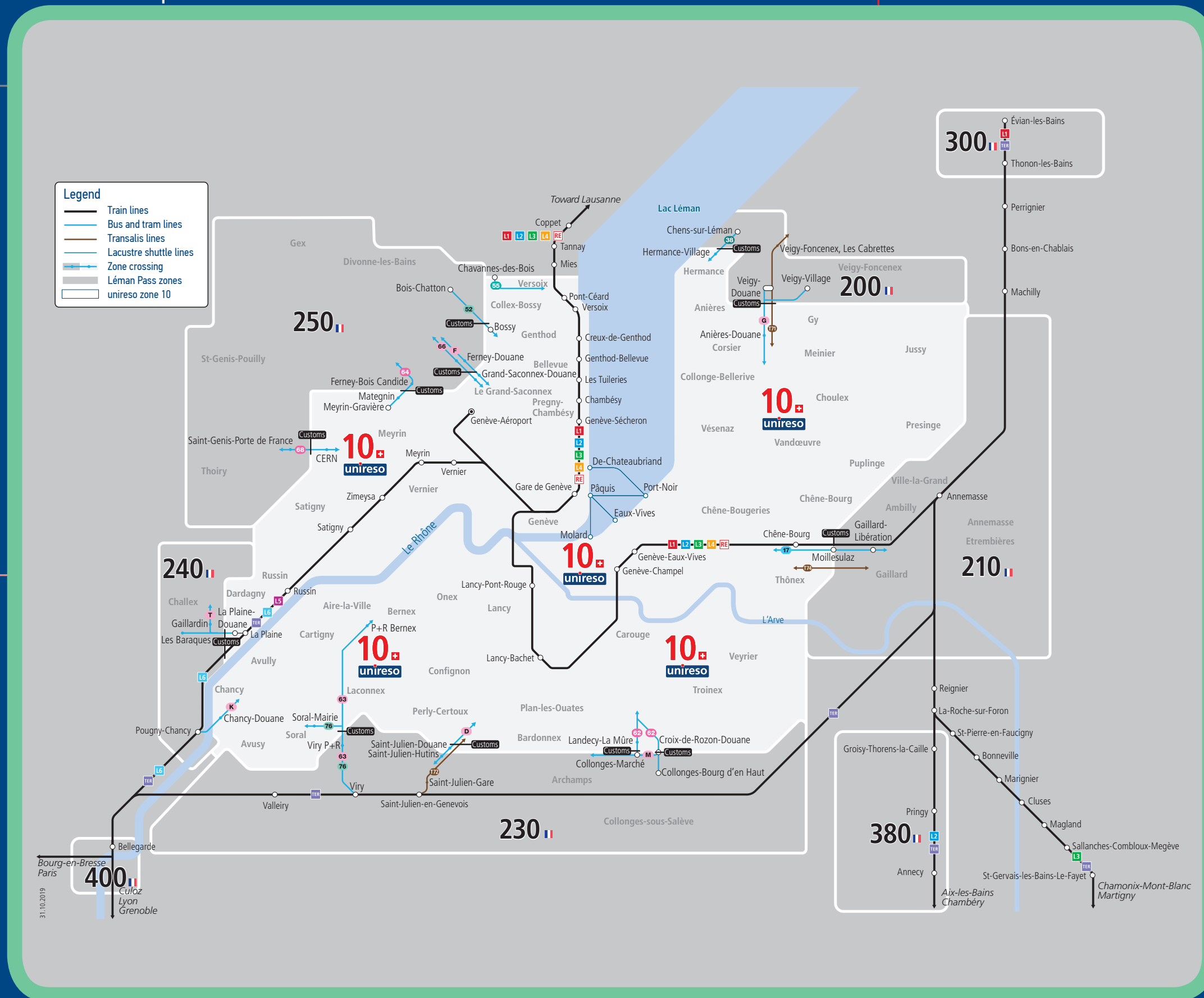

Trip Types

Geneva – Geneva Trips

If you are travelling within the canton of Geneva, known as zone 10 "Tout Genève", you will need a unireso ticket.

Geneva – France

If you are travelling from Geneva to France or vice-versa, you will need a Léman Pass ticket.
lemanpass.com 

Geneva – rest of Switzerland

If you are travelling from Geneva to another region in Switzerland, the Swiss national fare applies.


Valid only in unireso Zone 10

Zone 10 Tout Genève Ticket

For travel in zone 10 lasting 60 minutes.

Day Pass

For travel in zone 10 from the time of purchase until 5 a.m. the following day.

The full-fare day pass costs CHF 10 and is valid for two people travelling together on Saturday or Sunday.

9 a.m. Day Pass

For travel in zone 10 from 9 a.m. to 5 a.m. the following day.

Saut de puce (Quick Hop)

For travelling a maximum of 3 stops on the tpg line or on a Mouette taxi-boat in zone 10, one way without a connection.

Duo Pass

With the duo pass, if you have a monthly or annual full-fare adult pass, your partner living in the same house can buy a unireso pass at a reduced rate.

This offer is for women aged 25 to 64 and men aged 25 to 65. You must show proof of residency to get this offer. Offer limited to one duo pass per household.



Family Plan

Parents with a monthly or annual pass can show their family record book or certificate or any other official document proving they are parents, and each of their children can get the same pass at a reduced rate (CHF 40 or CHF 350).

Combined P+R Pass

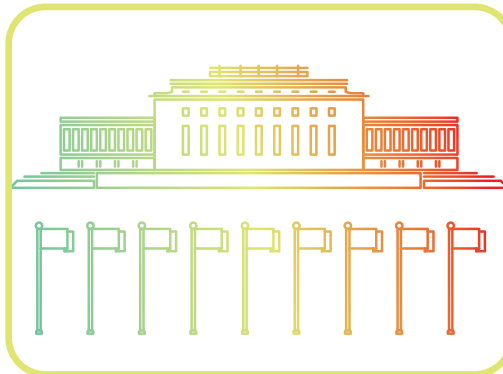
In partnership with unireso, the Fondation des Parkings offers a combined park and ride pass for your car or motorbike and a unireso Zone 10 (P+R) pass + bike parking (P+R+B), as applicable, for some car parks under certain eligibility conditions.

These passes are sold exclusively by the Fondation des Parkings.

unireso

unireso is the umbrella organization for a common fare system that includes three public transit systems in Geneva: CFF, tpg, Mouettes genevoises taxi-boats.



Reduced Fares

Reduced fares apply to these groups:

- youth aged 6 to 15, inclusive;
- holders of Swiss half-fare travel cards (not valid for passes);
- seniors of legal age for AVS social security (64 for women and 65 for men);
- AI disability insurance recipients (full pension);
- bikes.

Senior Category

The Senior Category starts at legal age for AVS social security (age 64 for women and 65 for men).

AI Category

For those receiving full AI disability insurance pensions, from age 25 to legal age for AVS social security.

Transferable

These passes can be used by anyone for a single fee, valid in zone 10.

Geneva Transport Card (GTC)

The GTC is an individual travel card given to guests when they arrive at a place of lodging in Geneva (hotel, inn, etc.).

Visitors can travel at no cost in all of zone 10 for the length of their stay (15 days maximum, renewable).

Insider Tips

Noctambus Network

Noctambus is available every Friday and Saturday night.

unireso and Léman Pass tickets are valid at no additional fee for use on the Noctambus night bus network, depending on bus route and length of validity.

Léman Pass Supplement

If you have a unireso ticket or pass and you want to travel to a bordering French zone, just buy a Léman Pass supplement.

- Travel to zones 200, 210 and 230: CHF 1.90
- Travel to zones 240 and 250: CHF 1.60

Valid for unireso and the rest of Switzerland (Alliance SwissPass)

Alliance SwissPass is the national rate system that includes all public transport operators and fare structures in Switzerland.

General Pass

With this general Alliance SwissPass, you can travel anywhere in any Swiss zone, including unireso, as far as the Annemasse train station, aboard a train.

Half-Fare Programme

With the Alliance SwissPass half-fare programme, you can buy unireso tickets, day passes, and 9 a.m. day passes at a reduced rate.

Not valid with longer passes.

Junior Card

With the Junior Card, children aged 6 to 15, inclusive, accompanied by a parent with a valid ticket, can ride the public transport system free for one year.

This card costs CHF 30.

Free with the third child.

Accompanied Child Card

With the Accompanied Child Card, children aged 6 to 15, inclusive, accompanied by another person (grandfather, grandmother, godfather, godmother, neighbour, aunt, uncle, caregiver, family friends, etc.), who has a valid ticket can ride the public transport system free for one year.

This card costs CHF 30.



Valid for unireso, Léman Pass, and the rest of Switzerland

SwissPass

With SwissPass, you can combine leisure activities (Mobility, ski passes, Velocity, and more) and public transport, including unireso passes Léman Pass, all on one no-contact card.

Junior Category

In Switzerland: ages 6 to 24, inclusive.

Children under Age 6

Children under age 6 accompanied by someone with a valid ticket ride free (maximum 8 children travelling with one adult.).

Transporting Bikes

Bicycles and other two-wheeled means of transport (electric bikes and electric scooters, two-wheeled devices up to 45 km/h not exceeding 35 kg) can be brought on board provided there is enough room and they do not disturb fellow passengers.

You must have a reduced-fare ticket valid for your trip in order to transport your bike.
